WS 23

Basic information:

Duration: 2 semester



Ects: 30+24, Thesis (30), Method and tools (9), Research seminar
 (3), Preparation (12)

- Registration to examination office 1 semester before submission
- Latest possible registration is in the 5th semester
- For Max-Planck-Institutes an affiliation with LMU is needed





8. Master Thesis

- How to choose a master thesis?
 - Decide the group/thesis few months prior to start
 - Talk with groups which might not interest you
 - Talk with group members and other students
 - If scientific career is aimed, a globally well-established group is beneficial
 - DONT underestimate supervising/personal skills





9. Examination office

- Old System:
- 1. Lecturer tells you to show up to exam
- 2. A "Schein" is given to the secretaries that you have to get there and send to the examination office



- New System:
- 1. You have to register for the exam via the LSF
- 2. Your grade is sent directly the the examination office, you have the send them a form so that they can count your grade towards for transcript
